

Town Meeting Warning

The legal voters of the Town of Guilford and Town School District of Guilford are hereby warned and notified to meet at the Guilford Central School in said Town of Guilford on Tuesday, the sixth (6th) day of March next at 10:00AM to act on the following articles, viz...

Voting for Selectpersons, School Directors, Lister, Auditor, Town Agent to be by Australian ballot between 10:00AM and 7:00PM.

ARTICLE 1. To elect a Moderator for the ensuing year.

ARTICLE 2. To act on the report of the Auditors.

ARTICLE 3. Shall the Town vote to appropriate \$616,889 and to raise through taxes and other sources of revenues, funds sufficient to defray the highway expenses for fiscal year July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008?

ARTICLE 4. Shall the Town vote to replace the present system of equipment earnings established in the 1962 town meeting with an accounting method which considers real and planned expenditures to begin in FY09.

ARTICLE 5. Shall the Town vote to appropriate \$374,676 and to raise through taxes and sources of revenues, funds sufficient to defray the general expenses for the fiscal year July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008?

ARTICLE 6. Shall the Town vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$19,000 for the Guilford Free Library?

ARTICLE 7. Shall the Town vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$69,500 for the Guilford Volunteer Fire Department?

ARTICLE 8. Shall the Town vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$5,000 to the Green River Covered Bridge Fund?

ARTICLE 9. Shall the Town vote to continue membership in the Windham Regional Commission and to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,109 to defray the Town's Share of its expense?

ARTICLE 10. Shall the Town vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$36,940 for the following Human Service Organizations:

ARTICLE 11. (By Petition) "Shall the Town of Guilford raise and appropriate the sum of \$1000 for Guilford Cares Inc?"

ARTICLE 12. (By Petition) "Shall the Town of Guilford raise and appropriate the sum of \$350 to support the Brattleboro Senior Meals – Meals on Wheels?"

ARTICLE 13. (By Petition) "Shall the Town of Guilford raise and appropriate the sum of \$300 to support the Boys & Girls Club of Brattleboro, Inc.?"

ARTICLE 14. (By Petition) "Shall the Town of Guilford raise and appropriate the sum of \$350 to support the Windham Child Care Association?"

ARTICLE 15. (By Petition) "Shall the Town of Guilford raise and appropriate the sum of \$250 to support the Connecticut River Transit?"

ARTICLE 16. To elect the following officers: Trustees for Public Funds, Grand Jurors(2), Library Trustee, Trustee of Cemetery Funds, Trustees of the Warren Wilder Fund, and Cemetery Commissioners?

ARTICLE 17. Shall the Town collect its taxes through the Treasurer without discount? Interest at 1% per month or fraction thereof will be charged after October 15th.

ARTICLE 18. Shall the Town authorize the Selectboard to borrow money on notes of the Town in anticipation of taxes and/or current expenses?

ARTICLE 19. (By petition) "Shall the voters of the town of Guilford advise the President, Congress and Vermont's state and federal office holders that Guilford and its citizens strongly support the men and women serving in all branches of the United States Armed forces in Iraq and believe that the best way to support them is to bring each and every one of them home now and take good care of them when they get home."

ARTICLE 20. (By petition) "We the undersigned voters of Guilford, hereby petition our board of selectmen to warn the resolution below for Town Meeting, March, 2007.

Whereas George W Bush and Richard B. Cheney have:

1. deliberately misled the nation about the treat from Iraq in order to justify a war,
2. condoned the torture of prisoners in violation of the Geneva Convention and US law,
3. approved illegal electronic surveillance of American citizens without a warrant, and, whereas these actions have undermined our Constitutional system of government, damaged the reputation of America, and threatened our national security.

Therefore, the voters of the town of Guilford call upon the U.S. House of Representatives to investigate these charges, and if the investigation supports the charges, vote to impeach George W. Bush and Richard B. Cheney as provided in the Constitution of the United States of America. This resolution shall be signed by the Town Clerk and forwarded to both the Speaker and the Clerk of the US House of Representatives, and Representative John Conyers of the House Judiciary Committee.

ARTICLE 21. To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.
